July 5TH is the busiest day for animal shelters all across the US?



Of those Pets that end up in Shelters...



Less Than 2% of Cats

&



15%-20% of Dogs

Ever make it home



Recognize & decrease your pet's stress and anxiety
Look for & Pay attention to the following:



Panting



Drooling



Pacing



Hiding



Abnormal urinations or defecations



Dilated pupils



Excessive grooming



Decreased appetite

Keep all cats and dogs indoors on & around the 4th.



Effectively restrain and maintain control over dogs out for a walk on and around the 4th.



You never know when an impromptu fireworks display is going to happen. Be sure that your dog is leashed up every time they leave your house and be sure to attach their leash before you open the door!

Ensure that all pets – even indoor cats – have legible & up-to-date identification.



The QR code ID tag by PetHub is an excellent means of identification.

Microchips are important, for all pets



Conduct an effective and thorough search for any pets that go missing. Contact all veterinary clinics, hospitals & animal shelters in your area. Post a "lost pet notice" on Craigslist & Reddit & check back daily.
