

8 TIPS TO KEEP YOUR DOG SAFE & STRESS-FREE THIS HALLOWEEN

1 CANDY (ESPECIALLY CHOCOLATE) CAN BE VERY DANGEROUS FOR DOGS. Many sugar free candies contain an artificial sweetener called XYLITOL which is toxic to dogs. IF FYDO EATS SOMETHING DANGEROUS CALL YOUR VET OR THE ASPCA POISON CENTER (888 426 4439) IMMEDIATELY.



2 CANDY WRAPPERS, PARTY SUPPLIES, TIN FOIL AND CELLOPHANE CAN BE VERY DANGEROUS IF SWALLOWED. KEEP WELL OUT OF REACH!

3 EATING DECORATIVE PUMPKINS OR CORN IS NOT TOXIC BUT CAN PRODUCE A VERY UPSET STOMACH.

4 KEEP WIRES AND CORDS FROM DECORATIVE LIGHTS OUT OF REACH!



IF CHEWED YOUR BELOVED COULD SUFFER CUTS, BURNS AND EVEN A LIFE THREATENING SHOCK!

5 BE CAREFUL WITH LIT PUMPKINS!



THEY CAN EASILY BE KNOCKED OVER BY A CURIOUS CREATURE AND CAUSE A FIRE!

6 UNLESS YOUR DOG IS SUPER SOCIAL, KEEP THEM IN A SEPARATE ROOM AWAY FROM THE CHAOS OF THE TRICK-OR-TREATERS WHO COME TO YOUR DOOR.

TOO MANY STRANGERS CAN OVERWHELM YOUR DOG AND CAUSE THEM TO BE UNUSUALLY PROTECTIVE OR AGGRESSIVE.



7 SOME DOGS LOVE BEING DRESSED IN COSTUME BUT MANY DO NOT. ONLY DRESS THEM UP IF YOU KNOW THEY LOVE IT AND IT DOES NOT CAUSE THEM STRESS.

8 IF YOU DO DRESS YOUR DOG IN COSTUME MAKE SURE IT'S SAFE AND TRY IT ON THE DAY BEFORE THE BIG EVENT. IT SHOULD NOT CONSTRICT BREATHING OR BARKING, OR IMPEDE HEARING, VISION OR MOVEMENT.



BEWARE OF SMALL DANGLING OR EASILY CHEWED OFF PIECES OF MATERIAL THAT COULD BECOME CHOKING HAZARDS. ALSO, WATCH FOR ANY SIGNS OF ALLERGIC REACTIONS TO COSTUMES.
